Brief about Event

A District-Level Sensitization Workshop on the Establishment and Implementation of Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) & Innovation Initiatives was held on 30th June 2025 at Saurashtra University, Rajkot. The program was organized by the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell (MIC), AICTE, in collaboration with Ahmedabad Indovation Centre and Saurashtra University, aiming to strengthen innovation and entrepreneurial frameworks across HEIs.

The first technical session was delivered by Shri Shyamsundar S., Regional Manager – IP & Technology Transfer at MIC-AICTE. He provided an insightful overview of India's innovation landscape, the role of HEIs in fostering a culture of creativity, and strategies for institutional involvement in innovation and entrepreneurship. His session focused on ecosystem development, IP management, and capacity-building for innovation leaders within academic institutions.

In the second session, Dr. Ijan Vaidya, OSD, Department of Higher Education, Government of Gujarat, conducted a deep-dive into the Innovation & Startup Lifecycle. He discussed various phases from ideation, validation, and prototyping to startup launch and scaling. His talk emphasized building structured innovation pipelines within HEIs, including support mechanisms like pre-incubation and mentoring.

The third session was led by Shri Mitesh Vadher, Innovation Fellow at MIC-AICTE. He highlighted the importance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and explained the various government grants, schemes, and support programs available to innovators and institutions. He encouraged participants to leverage central and state-level funding opportunities and stressed the need for early IP awareness and protection in the innovation process.

The workshop concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Harikrishna Parikh, Vice President of IIC, followed by a networking lunch. The sessions collectively offered valuable knowledge and actionable insights for building innovation capacity in academic institutions.

The District-Level Sensitization Workshop at Jamnagar focused on creating awareness about the role of HEIs in nurturing innovation and startups through the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC). The sessions covered key aspects such as innovation practices, startup lifecycle management, and institutional responsibilities.

Speakers like Shri Shyamsundar S., Dr. Keyur Parmar, and Shri Mitesh Vadher highlighted the importance of entrepreneurship, IPR, and government support schemes. The workshop gave participants clarity on how to transform innovative ideas into startups with institutional and policy support.

The Morbi workshop emphasized the integration of innovation culture in higher education. The event included sessions by Shri Shyamsundar S., Mr. Vivek Patel, and Shri Mitesh Vadher, focusing on entrepreneurship development, startup growth stages, and intellectual property rights.

Faculty and students were made aware of various government grants, incubation opportunities, and mentorship models that can strengthen institutional innovation pipelines. Practical insights

into startup development motivated participants to actively engage in entrepreneurial activities.

Held at Surendranagar, this sensitization workshop reinforced the need for structured innovation systems within HEIs. The program featured talks by Shri Shyamsundar S., Mr. Sandeep Takwani, and Shri Mitesh Vadher, covering entrepreneurship ecosystems, startup lifecycle management, and IPR awareness.

The workshop encouraged participants to adopt best practices for innovation-led growth, while also promoting collaboration among institutions. Discussions highlighted the role of incubation centers, funding avenues, and interdisciplinary efforts in building sustainable startups.
