Brief about Event

World Creativity and Innovation Day, the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell (MIC), in collaboration with AICTE, hosted the grand inauguration of IP UTSAV (21st – 26th April 2025). The event aimed to promote innovation, intellectual property (IP) literacy, and the celebration of creativity across India. The theme of the Utsav, "IP and Music: Feel the Beat of IP", highlighted the importance of IP in fostering a vibrant, creative ecosystem.

Over 10,000 Institutions Innovation Councils (IICs) participated in the session, engaging a diverse audience of more than 1 million, including students, researchers, and faculty members.

Prof. (Dr.) Unnat Pandit

Controller General of Patents, Designs & Trademarks; Registrar of Copyrights & GIs, DPIIT, Government of India

Prof. Unnat Pandit inaugurated the session with an inspiring message on building a Viksit Bharat through a robust and inclusive innovation ecosystem. He emphasized the role of intellectual property (IP) as a foundation for supporting creativity, especially in cultural domains like music. Highlighting the government's support for IP protection and awareness, he called for collective efforts to establish a healthy and inclusive IP ecosystem in India.

His presentation placed India's innovation ecosystem within a global context, highlighting its rising trajectory in the Global Innovation Index.
