## Brief about Event

SU Startup & Entrepreneurship Council In association with: IIC, Department of Computer Science and SPRIHA, Saurashtra University, for an Awareness Programme on SSIP 2.0 and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR), was aimed at empowering innovators and budding entrepreneurs on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2025 from 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm.

The session was delivered by Mr. Parth Sejpal, IPR Chair Professor, SPRIHA, Saurashtra University, who emphasized an awareness Programme on SSIP 2.0 and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) was successfully conducted to enlighten students and faculty about the significance of innovation, entrepreneurship, and legal protection of intellectual assets.

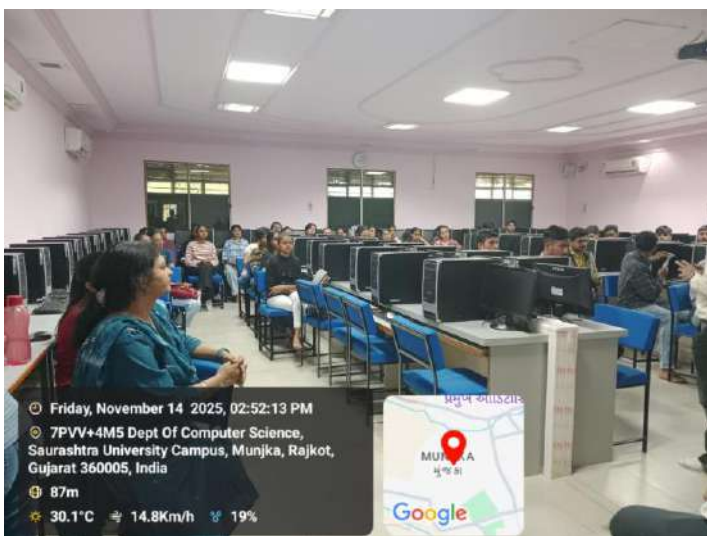
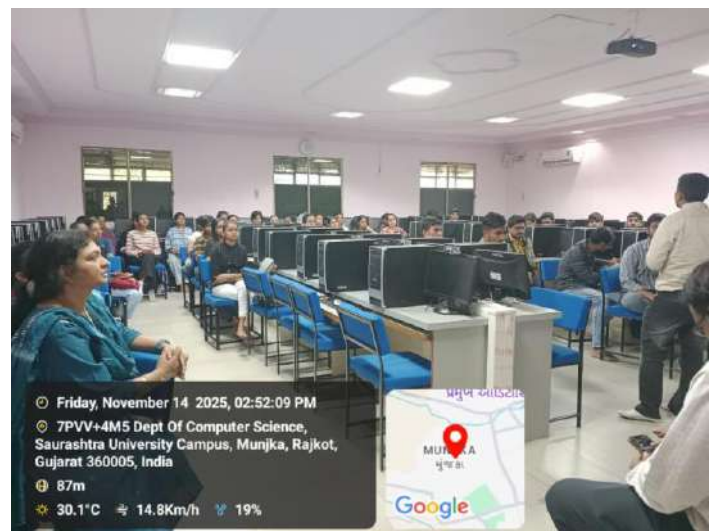
